## SAFETY

### HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CYCLISTS

Riders are encouraged to carry an **ID**, **Emergency contact information** and a **cell phone**. Riders under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

### AWARDS

Awards are presented to the first overall male and female winners in the 5k / 10k runs and to the TOP finisher in each age group: 12-under, 13-19, 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59, 60-69, 70-79 & 80 & over.

**Each Registered Participant** receives a Free T-shirt, participation medal, and breakfast and lunch. **SAG** service is provided.

### SUPERVISED CHILD ACTIVITIES

Adult volunteers will be available to supervise the children of participants. Parents must sign a liability waiver and indicate the number of children on the registration form.

Established in 1992, Habitat for Humanity of Scotland County has built 47 homes in partnership with local families in need. Our mission is to eliminate sub-standard housing in our county.
