SAFETY

HELMETS ARE REQUIRED FOR ALL CYCLISTS

All Riders are encouraged to carry an **ID**, **Emergency contact information** and a **cell phone**.

Youth Riders under 16 must be accompanied by an adult.

AWARDS

Each Registered Participant receives a Free T-shirt, finisher medal, and breakfast and lunch. **SAG** service is provided.

SUPERVISED CHILD ACTIVITIES

Adult volunteers will be available to supervise the children of participants. Parents must sign a liability waiver and indicate the number of children on the registration form.

Teams: Bike as a team of four or more people! Ask family, church groups, businesses, biking/walking clubs, friends, etc. to join you. Enter your team info on the registration form.

Established in 1992, Habitat for Humanity of Scotland County has built 49 homes in partnership with local families in need. In 2019 Habitat repaired over 125 homes. Our mission is to eliminate sub-standard housing in our county.
